Applications are invited from intending candidates for admission into one year M. Phil. Course (Semester pattern) in the following subjects for the academic session 2011-12.

REGULAR COURSES

Botany, Chemistry, Economics, Physics and Zoology having 10 seats each including four seats under self financing mode.

SELF FINANCE COURSES (SFC)

Anthropology & Tribal Studies, Commerce, Education, English, History, Oriya, Philosophy, Political Science, Public Administration, Sanskrit, Sociology and Women's Studies having 10 seats in each subject.

Eligibility: Master's Degree in the concerned subject from any recognized University with at least 48% of marks or equivalent grade. However, Master's in Tribal Studies/ Anthropology can apply for Anthropology & Tribal Studies and Master's in any discipline can apply for Women's Studies. In-service candidates are required to apply through proper channel.
